This consultation runs for six weeks from **Tuesday 29 January to Monday 11 March 2019**.

What is the consultation about?

We have developed a range of improvements to make it easier for people to walk and/or cycle along the most popular travel routes in Hereford. These improvements will be possible to deliver with the construction of a future bypass that could reduce pressure on Hereford's busy transport network.

We would like to hear your opinions on these proposals and learn more about what would encourage and enable you to walk, cycle or use the bus more often.

Why are the improvements needed?

The walking, cycling, bus and public space improvements are designed to work together with the bypass to make Hereford a better place to live, work, study and visit.

By improving our transport network, we aim to encourage people to choose to walk, cycle or travel by bus more often and reduce dependency on the car for shorter journeys.
